Re: Notice of Governing Member Election and/or Notice to Submit Measure(s) to a Vote of the Voters

RECOMMENDATION

Review and approve Resolution to submit member selection to San Joaquin County Registrar of Votes for the 2026 Election year.

BACKGROUND

Tracy Rural Fire District Board Members are elected by the public during general elections and serve a four-year term. The District Election is November 3, 2026 with three Board Members whose terms expire December 2026.

DISCUSSION

Per California Elections Code Section 10509, the San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters Office requires a resolution from TRFD requesting election services. Said election shall be to fill a vacancy for the following Board Members: Pete Reece, Craig Miller and John Viera. Directors are elected at large. ROV requests the resolution to be filed by June 22, 2026. Candidate filing for Director positions opens July 13, 2026 and closed August 7, 2026. Nomination papers will be available at the San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters during these dates. ROV suggests requesting an appointment via the Candidate Service Tab on the ROV website www.sjcrov.org.

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TRACY RURAL COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT DECLARING AN ELECTION BE HELD; REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION WITH OTHER ELECTIONS ON THE SAME DATE; AND REQUESTING ELECTION SERVICES FROM THE COUNTY REGISTRAR OF VOTERS.

WHEREAS, under the Elections Code § 10400-10418, the governing body of a special district may request consolidation of its election with the statewide general election or another election date; and specifically § 10404 provides a mechanism for special districts to hold elections on the same day as the statewide general election.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Tracy Rural County Fire Protection District desires to hold such election on November 3, 2026 for the purpose of electing members to its Board and/or submitting measure(s) to voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

An election is hereby ordered to be held on November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing members of the Governing Board of the District and/or submitting measure(s) to the voters of the District.
